### CoolSign Display Engine (DE3) Quick Setup Guide CoolSign Display Engine 3

The CoolSign Display Engine 3 (DE3) is a powerful, high-performance compact player for the CoolSign digital signage system. The DE3 exploits CoolSign's sophisticated multi-layer compositing for complete independent control of all elements. Tickers play at 60 frames per second (fps) full motion with no stuttering! In addition, the Display Engine 3 (DE3) is offered with Windows 7 or Windows 10. Both are premium digital signage players for high-quality graphics, overlays, and video content.

## Setting up the Appliance

### Prerequisites

An existing CoolSign network is required to operate the Display Engine 3.

### What's in the box?

The CoolSign Display Engine 3 kit consists of the following:

- 1 CoolSign Display Engine 3
- 1 HDMI cable
- 1 power supply and power cord



### Hardware Installation

- 1. Unpack the box and position the hardware.
- 2. Connect the DE3 to a display/monitor.
- Connect the DE3 to your network using an Ethernet cable (*not included*). The DE3, by default, requests an IP address from a DHCP server on your network. If you don't have a DHCP server on your network, you will need to assign a static IP address to the player.
- 4. Plug a keyboard and mouse into the DE3.
- 5. Plug the power cord into the power supply (*included*).
- 6. Plug the power supply in to the DE3.
- 7. Push the power button on the front of the DE3 (the Status LED will light).

#### Software Installation

After the CoolSign Display Engine 3 has fully booted, the screen will be black with no icons on it. Run the CoolSign Configurator to connect the player to the network:

- 1. Press the Windows key on the keyboard to display the desktop.
- 2. From the Start menu, launch the CoolSign Configurator.
- 3. Connect the CoolSign Display Engine 3 to a CoolSign network. The player is tuned to the default channel. Refer to the "Configuring Installed Nodes" in the CoolSign Installation Manual for details.

#### Important

You must choose a value for Audio Output on the Player Node: Player Information page of the Configurator, or the Display Engine 3 will not connect correctly to the network.
